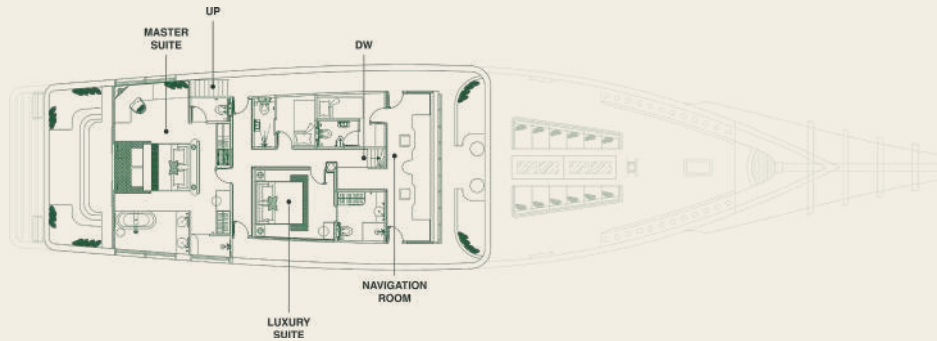
Samsara Samudra is the sister vessel to Samsara Ubud, a Michelin Key property and member of Preferred Hotels & Resorts LVX.



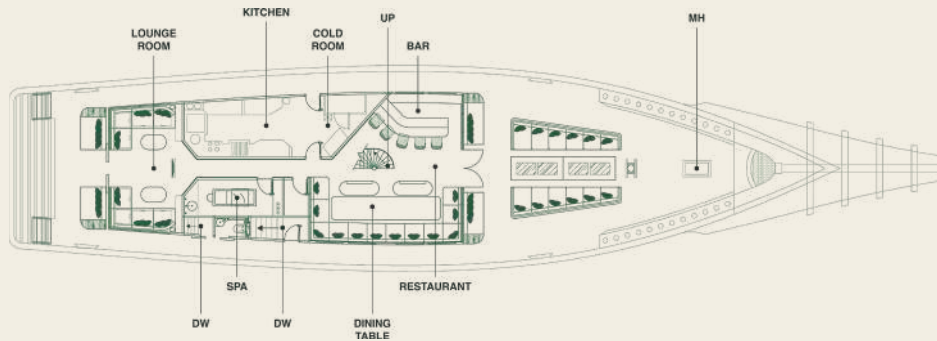

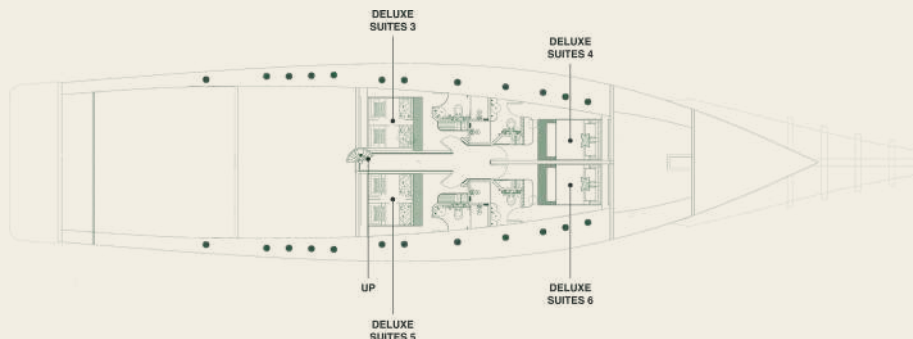
Upper Deck

Komodo Islands

Sail into Komodo National Park, where turquoise water meets rugged volcanic hills and the legendary Komodo dragon still roams free across Rinca Island. Beyond the dragons, the islands reveal some of Indonesia's most photographed landscapes — the panoramic ridgelines of Gili Lawa Darat, the reef life of Sabolo and Sabayor, and Pink Beach, one of only seven pink-sand beaches on Earth.

Best Season : April – November

Minimum : 3 Nights

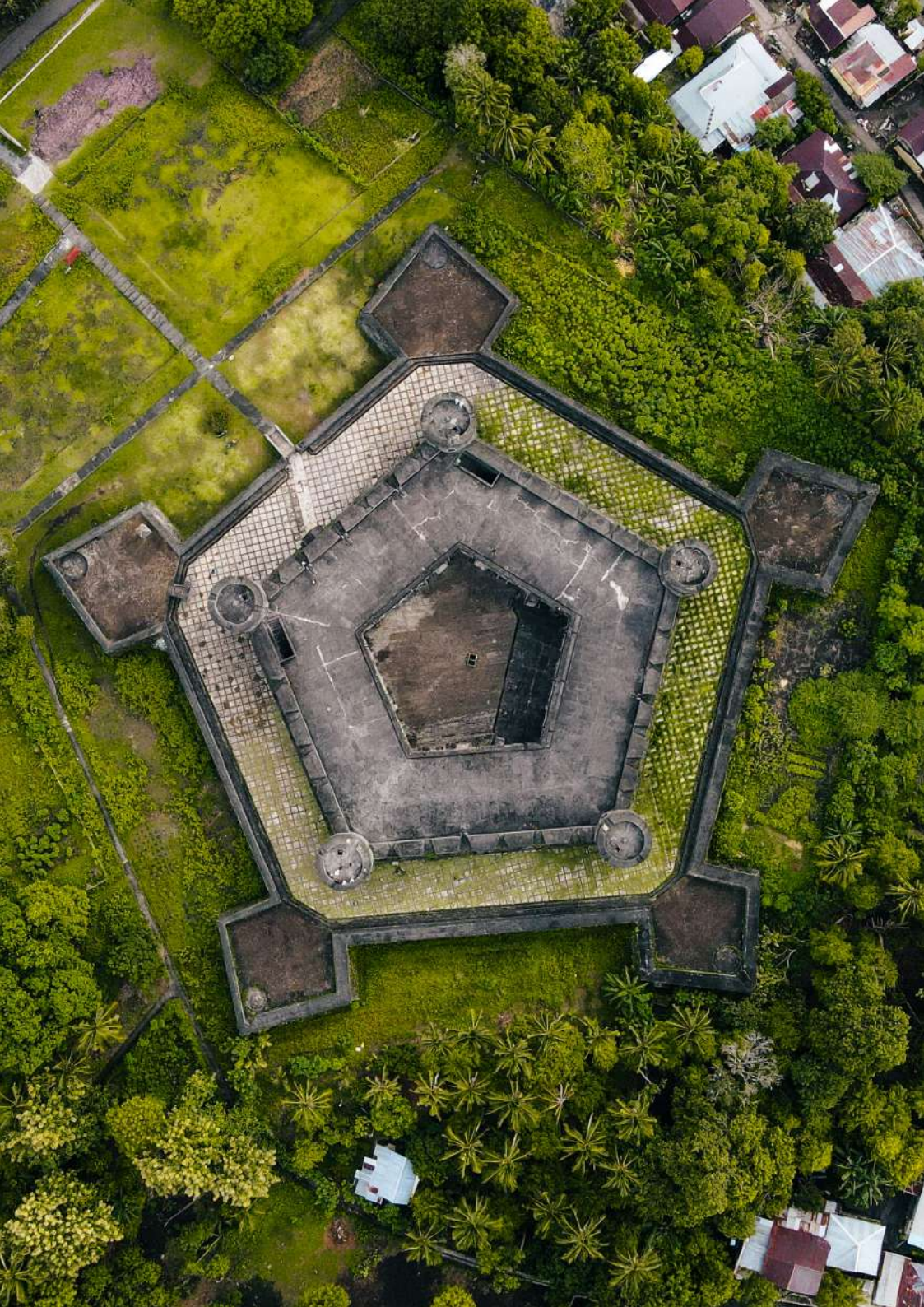
Raja Ampat

Off the Bird's Head Peninsula of West Papua, Raja Ampat is widely considered the most biodiverse marine environment on the planet — home to over 1,200 species of fish, 550 types of coral and six of the world's seven sea turtle species. Above the surface, the islands hold their own wonders: cave paintings, WWII shipwrecks and the iconic limestone peaks of Wayag, best seen from a jungle trek viewpoint.

Best Season : November – April

Minimum : 5 Nights





DESTINATIONS

Spice Islands

In the Spice Islands, every voyage reveals a different side of Indonesia. Wander through the historic streets of Banda Neira, explore centuries-old forts and nutmeg plantations, then spend your days diving untouched reefs, cruising beneath volcanic peaks, and anchoring in quiet bays far from the crowds.

Best Season : October – April
